



Guidance for visitors: Coronavirus (COVID-19)

As advised by the government on 16/3/20, if you have symptoms of coronavirus infection (COVID-19), however mild, you must not visit our site. Stay home for a minimum of 7 days from when your symptoms started. All members of your household should also stay at home and self-isolate for a period of 14 days, even if they appear unaffected.

The symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) are recent onset of:

- new continuous cough and/or
- high temperature
